- Complete online coursework at our Central Administrative office under the guidance of a preceptor two days per week
- Have guidance and support of an assigned MA preceptor/mentor working elbow to elbow three days a week, learning hands on skills that correlate to the learning of an accredited online Medical Assistant program

Upon completion of the Intern Program, you will be able to work as a Medical Assistant in an IHA office and pursue credentialing through the National Healthcareer Association.

IHA partners with multiple area schools and community colleges.

You choose the school or community college to attend, and enroll in their medical assistant program. You will have the ability to work part-time or full-time around your class schedule as a Medical Receptionist or Clinical Support Assistant.
